He forced Claudia to work, while he stayed home and became an alcoholic. She was the sole provider for their family and was only allowed to leave the house to work.

Position schedule: Sunday & Monday 10:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. This position ensures the day to day operation of our emergency shelter kitchen, utilizing the community contributions program with participants. Employee will use holistic model to support participants in healthy meal preparation, maintaining a clean and healthy cooking environment, and gardening skills, while being mindful of possible triggers related to domestic abuse. Bilingual (English/Spanish) required. High School Diploma or equivalent and 2 years of relevant experience.

## Volunteer Needs

**Crisis Advocate Volunteers:** As a crisis advocate volunteer you will answer crisis calls, assess safety of callers, assist in clarifying needs, issues and concerns, provide referrals for local resources and screen for entry into our programs. Crisis Advocate volunteers will receive training on procedures and protocol. We are currently seeking assistance for two day and one evening shift between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**Children's Program Bilingual Volunteer:** We are in search of a bilingual volunteer to help with our children's program on Tuesday evenings 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. You will assist the Child and Family Case coordinator with the healthy relationships lesson plans and projects.

**Voices Against Violence Center Assistant:** Duties include: answering the phone, monitoring the entrance, and some light admin duties and special projects. The schedule is flexible; we could use assistance anytime time during the work week.

**Program Support Volunteer:** We are in search of a volunteer to help us with our weekly errands. The primary duties would be to pick up food and diapers and deliver them to the shelter. Schedule is flexible. A background check and training will be required.

## Internet and Computer Safety

- If you think your activities are being monitored, they probably are. Abusive people are often controlling and want to know your every move. You don't need to be a computer programmer or have special skills to monitor someone's computer and Internet activities - anyone can do it and there are many ways to monitor with programs like spyware, keystroke loggers and hacking tools.
- It is not possible to delete or clear all the "footprints" of your computer or online activities. If you are being monitored, it may be dangerous to change your computer behaviors such as suddenly deleting your entire Internet history if that is not your regular habit.
- If you think you may be monitored on your home computer, be careful how you use your computer since an abuser might become suspicious. You may want to keep using the monitored computer for innocuous activities, like looking up the

weather. Use a safer computer to research an escape plan, look for new jobs or apartments, bus tickets, or ask for help.

- Email and Instant/Text Messaging (IM) are not safe or confidential ways to talk to someone about the danger or abuse in your life. If possible, please call the Emerge! hotline instead. If you use email or IM, please use a safer computer and an account your abuser does not know about.
- Computers can store a lot of private information about what you look at via the Internet, the emails and instant messages you send, internet-based phone and IP-TTY calls you make, web-based purchases and banking, and many other activities.
- It might be safer to use a computer in a public library, at a trusted friend's house, or an Internet Café.
