

August 6, 2015 - A murder-suicide discovered by Tucson police earlier this month brought to light a harsh reality - on average, someone dies in Arizona every three days as a result of domestic violence.

Authorities believe that, after a recent breakup, Marc Florio shot and killed Natalie Beissel before using the gun to end his own life.
